Tournament Rules

- 1. This tournament is open to all USBC women members living in this jurisdiction as defined by USBC who have reached their 50th birthday before they bowl in this tournament. Age is based on the date of the tournament
- 2. This tournament will be a three (3) game singles event. There will be two divisions, based on age, each with a separate prize fund. Division A: Age 50 to 64; Division B: Age 65 & over.
- 3. Entrants must be sanctioned members of the West Volusia USBC.
- 4. The deadline for mail-in entries is March 24, 2020. Walk-in entries will be accepted on the day of the tournament. Bowlers and walk-in entries must check in at least 30 minutes prior to bowling.
- 5. Entering averages: Entrant must use highest sanctioned average of 21 games or more from either the West Volusia USBC 2018-2019 Yearbook or 2019 summer season. If no West Volusia USBC 2018-2019 Yearbook average or 2019 summer average for 21 games or more, the current season highest 21 game league average as of the tournament date must be used. Bowlers must provide proof of this average at check-in. If none of the above is available, they must bowl scratch. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify scores bowled if submitted average is lower than actual average, thereby resulting in a lower classification for more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the actual average. Tournament management reserves the right to adjust averages upward or downward if the event verification reveals incorrectly submitted averages.
- 6. Lane Assignments:
 - a. Mail-in/hand-in entries will be assigned lanes by random draw. You may request to be paired with other bowlers
 - b. Walk-in entries will be assigned lanes that are available after the mail-in entries have been assigned lanes.
- 7. USBC rules 319a-2 (10 pin rule) and 319a-4 (bowler average responsibility and average correction time frame) ARE IN EFFECT.
- 8. USBC rules 319d (reporting Previous Prize Winnings) and 319e (Average Adjustment for Entry) ARE NOT IN EFFECT.
- 9. Handicap will be 90% of 220.
- 10. All prize money will be returned 100%. Payout is 1 for every 4 entries in each division.
- 11. In the event of a tie for first place, a one-game roll-off will be held immediately. A tie for any other places will have prize monies combined and divided equally.
- 12. The winner in each division shall have their participation fee reimbursed by West Volusia USBC for either the 2020 Florida State Women's Senior Tournament or the 2021 Florida State Senior Open Tournament. A copy of the tournament recap sheets must be submitted to receive reimbursement. In the event the first place winner is unable to participate in the Florida State Senior Tournament, the bowler with the next highest score will be eligible to take their place.
- 13. An imprinted tumbler or polo shirt will be presented to the winner of each division at the annual awards event.
- 14. United States Bowling Congress (USBC) rules govern this tournament.
